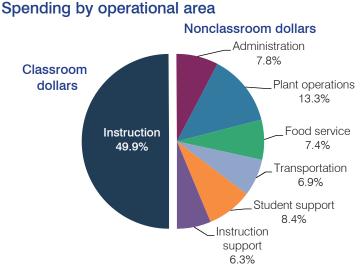

5-year spending trend (2009 through 2014)

Total spending per pupil decreased by 1 percent. Spending in the classroom was very inconsistent, decreasing overall from 51.1 to 49.9 percent. Overall, spending on food service increased and spending on administration increased slightly. Spending on instruction support decreased and spending on student support decreased slightly.

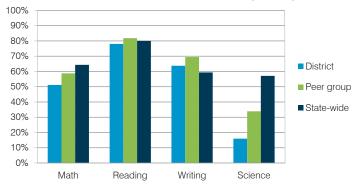

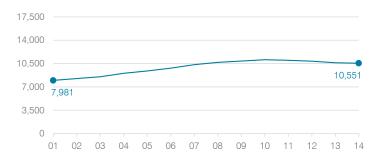

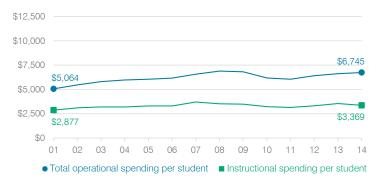

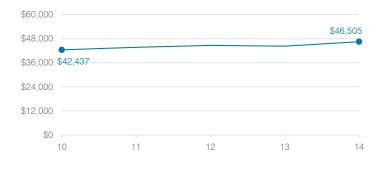
Total operational and instructional spending per student



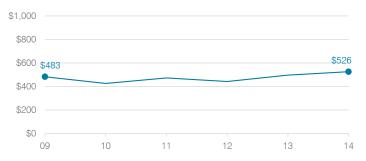
Changes in operational spending percentages



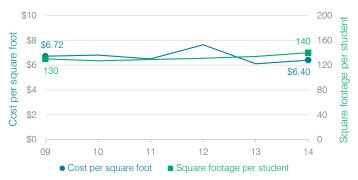
Average teacher salary
